

Negro Youth, 14, Dies in Chair

COLUMBIA, S. C.—(U.P.)—George Stinney, 14-year-old negro, died yesterday in South Carolina's electric chair. He was the youngest chair victim in the state's history.

Stinney carried a Bible into the execution chamber, and refused to comment on the death sentence he drew for the slaying of an 11-year-old girl. Previously he had confessed the iron pipe killing as well as the slaying of an eight-year-old girl for which he was not tried.
