

Therefore, the Court will release the defendant subject to the conditions that he continue counseling with the local mental health department and report as recommended by them. The defendant shall continue taking medications as prescribed and supervised by mental health.

MOTION FOR COURT-ORDERED MENTAL EXAMINATION OF DEFENDANT AND FOR ORDER AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE

COMES NOW Angela Cochran Morgan, the undersigned attorney of record for Lenion Richard Barnett, Jr., the Defendant in the above-styled case, and moves this Honorable Court to order a mental examination of the Defendant to be conducted at such time or times as the Court may direct, by a psychologist or psychiatrist, to determine:

- 1. The Defendant's sufficient present ability to assist in his defense, by consulting with counsel, with a reasonable degree of rational understanding of the facts and the legal proceedings pending before the Court; and
- 2. The mental condition of the Defendant at the time of the alleged offenses, and that the prosecution of this case be stayed pending the outcome of such examination.

As attorney for the Defendant, I believe that it is essential for a mental examination to be conducted in advance of trial for the following reasons:

- a. The Defendant is charged with two counts of theft of property in the first degree.
- b. The Defendant has been diagnosed with schizophrenia and major depression.
- c. The Defendant suffered from schizophrenia and major depression at the time of the alleged offenses, and the Defendant currently suffers from schizophrenia and major depression.
- d. The Defendant is currently receiving treatment from the CED Mental Health Center in Fort Payne, Alabama. The Defendant has advised the undersigned attorney that he has also been

hospitalized at psychiatric facilities in Guntersville, Decatur, and Anniston. The undersigned attorney is currently attempting to obtain documentation regarding the specific facilities at which the Defendant was hospitalized.

e. It is the opinion of the undersigned attorney, based on investigation, that the said Defendant's psychiatric conditions directly led to him being charged with the offenses in this matter and that, due to his psychiatric conditions, the Defendant did not understand the criminality of his actions at that time.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the undersigned attorney respectfully moves that the Court will Order examination of the Defendant by a mental health professional, and further Order the said mental health professional to make report to the Court by and through the Defendant's attorney of record. Further, said attorney prays that the Court will authorize, order, and direct any institution or physician which may be discovered to have such information about the Defendant's psychiatric treatment to deliver up any and all records from that institution or physician pertaining to the Defendant, particularly all medical and mental health records of the identity, diagnosis, prognosis, and treatment of the Defendant, which are or were maintained in connection with the performance of any program or activity relating to education, training, treatment, rehabilitation, or research at any institution, as well as records of the contacts, counseling, result of medical, psychological, and psychiatric testing and the evaluations, diagnosis, and prognosis of the Defendant, which are or were maintained in connection with the performance of any program, treatment, or activity relating to this physical or mental health or mental health training, treatment, rehabilitation, or research into this condition.

Assault suspect still at large

Last night at approximately 9:20 p.m. Erlanger Hospital requested a transport of a patient to Moccasin Bend on a Certificate of Need. Corrections Officer Sanders responded to Erlanger Hospital to pick the party up then proceed to Moccasin Bend. As the vehicle

reached Hamm Road, the party identified as Lenion R. Barnett became agitated and combative in the backseat of the patrol vehicle and kicked the entire screen barrier out. He grabbed the Officer around the throat, choking him and then attempted to remove the Officers weapon from his holster. The Officer managed to get the vehicle stopped while still involved in the altercation with the party, at which time they both fell from the vehicle onto the pavement. The party then broke and ran into the wooded area next to Hamm road.

A search was initiated for the suspect involving Law Enforcement from both the Hamilton County Sheriff so Office and the Chattanooga Police Department. The search continued on until 2:30 a.m. this morning using K-9 dogs from both agencies with no success. HCSO was back searching this morning at daylight for the suspect who is described as a w/m age 30, 5 8 weighing 200 lbs. with brown hair and hazel eyes. He was wearing a hospital gown and shorts but these items were found in the wooded area during the initial search.
