# Truck Hits Wires, Two Electrocuted

**SOUTH WINDSOR** — The owner of a construction company and one of his workers were electrocuted after a dump truck's bed hit overhead electrical wires Wednesday morning.

Lloyd Folsom, 55, the owner of

Folsom Construction, and Connor Betts, 22, received electrical shocks after the truck hit the wires on the company's Rye Street property about 11 a.m., according to Laura Briggs, an office manager at the company.

It appeared that Betts was injured after he raised the dump bed and it touched the wires,
