

## 10 Non-Tenure Teachers Hired by Riverdale Board

The non-tenure teachers are: Nicholas Del Rel, Mrs. Marguerite Maccagnano and Mrs. Carole Doud, all special education; Mrs. Helen Stoess, third grade; Mrs. Gail Dedio and Mrs. Naomi Davisson, both fifth grade; Mrs. Sharon Ercolano, sixth; Mrs. Patricia Dashner, art, and Mrs. Elizabeth Warren, speech therapy, two days a week.

Richard Klein was rehired as a psychologist one day a week. Lawrence Van Volkenburgh of Ringwood was hired as a building custodian effective May 3. He will succeed Joseph

Shargay who is retiring after 16 years in the system.

The board approved for the sixth year a summer music program which will be conducted four weeks in August by Ernest Stuber.

Stuber will present his students in their annual spring concert May 4, at 7:30 p.m. The instrumental program will feature the Junior and Senior Bands as well as ensembles. Some 95 children will be participating.
